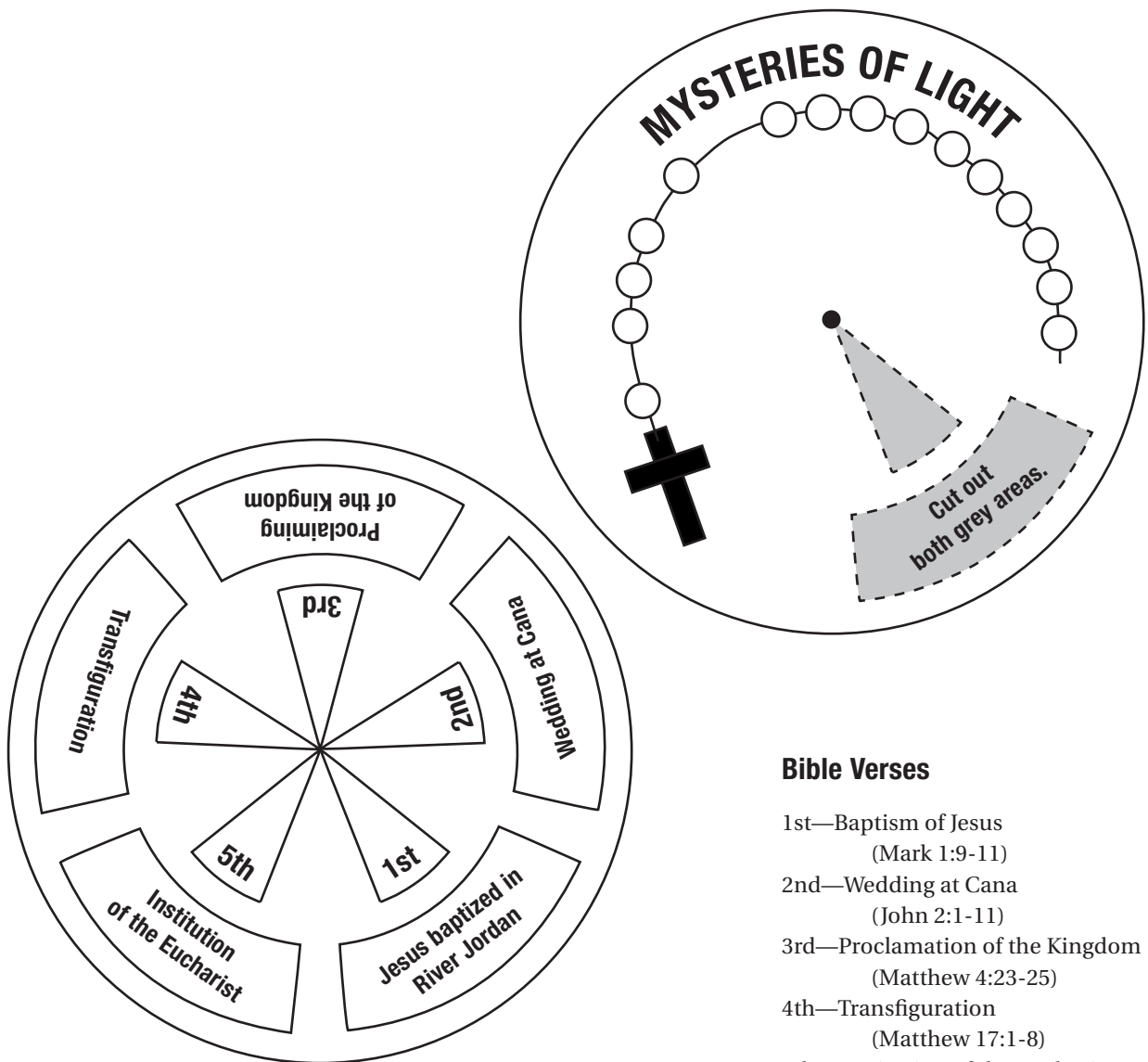


Mysteries of Light Wheel

The Mysteries of Light (or Luminous Mysteries) were created by Pope John Paul II at the beginning of his 25th anniversary year as a Pope. They join the Joyful, Sorrowful, and Glorious Mysteries for our reflection while we say the rosary, and are usually used on Thursdays. They include the period of Jesus' life during his ministry.

Cut out the two circles of the Mysteries of Light Wheel, along with the spaces labeled "cut out." Secure the circles together with a brad. Turn to the first Mystery of Light, the Baptism of Jesus. Think about what took place at the Baptism and who was present. Use the Bible verses given at the bottom right to help you with each Mystery of Light.



Bible Verses

- 1st—Baptism of Jesus
(Mark 1:9-11)
- 2nd—Wedding at Cana
(John 2:1-11)
- 3rd—Proclamation of the Kingdom
(Matthew 4:23-25)
- 4th—Transfiguration
(Matthew 17:1-8)
- 5th—Institution of the Eucharist
(Luke 22:14-20)
